

Dear Parents

We want all children to be able to enjoy each field trip. Each child is given several warnings before loss of this privilege. Field trips are rewards and children will earn them by exhibiting positive behavior. We can make you aware if they are close to losing a field trip. Children that will not listen to our staff will not be allowed to go on any trips until they show us that they are able to follow directions. The reason for this is that a lot of trips we go on have multiple childcare centers or the groups are very large. It is too dangerous to take a child out of the center that will not follow directions. I will list the behaviors that will lose trips for each age group

3 year olds will lose a field trip for

- hitting, spitting, slapping, or kicking friends
- uncontrollable behaviors such as screaming, kicking, slapping teachers
- touching emergency doors on bus or unbuckling while in motion
- for dangerous behaviors on trips such as leaving group

4 year olds will lose a field trip for

- receiving an X for behavior
- touching emergency doors on bus or unbuckling while in motion
- for dangerous behaviors on trips such as leaving group
- hitting, spitting, slapping, or kicking friends
- uncontrollable behaviors such as screaming, kicking, slapping teachers
- talking during roll call during trip (this is the most important because we have to make sure everyone is present. Sometimes there are 100 children at our venue!)

After school children will lose a field trip for

- receiving an X for behavior
- touching emergency doors on bus or unbuckling while in motion
- for dangerous behaviors on trips such as leaving group
- hitting, spitting, slapping, or kicking friends
- uncontrollable behaviors such as screaming, kicking, slapping teachers
- talking during roll call during trip (this is the most important because we have to make sure everyone is present. Sometimes there are 100 children at our venue!)
- inappropriate language
- deliberately picking on other i.e.calling names or making fun of another student
