

Summer Field Trip Guide **Children must show 1 week of positive behavior prior to attending any field trips**

We are excited to enter another fun and busy summer. This handbook will provide you with vital information about trips and rules. Each field trip has its cost listed on the calendar and payment for each trip should be in cash prior to that trip. **All children must be potty trained to attend field trips.**

After school children must show 1 week of positive behavior prior to attending any field trips

Field Trip Destinations and Rules

Swimming

Swimming will be at a Lancaster County Parks and Rec pool on Wylie St in Lancaster. All children are required to take a swim test to play in the deeper areas of the pool. There is a shallow area for children who cannot swim yet to play. Once your child passes the swim test they will receive a wrist band that will help us and lifeguards keep track of who has passed the swim test. The only equipment permitted in the pool are swim caps and goggles. No arm floats or any pool toy is allowed. Your child will need to bring their swimsuit, a towel, and sunscreen on days that we swim.

Rules

If a child goes in deeper areas without a wrist band;

1st offense – timeout

2nd offense – loss of swimming for that day

3rd offense – will not return to the pool for the remainder of the summer

Movies

Movies are at Redstone in Indian Land. The cost for the movies is \$1.00 per. The children are also allowed to bring extra money for snack and drink. Popcorn \$1 and kids drink \$1

Sport's Connection

Sport's Connection is located on Audrey Kell Rd in South Charlotte. The cost is \$7.00 per visit for 1 ½ hours of jump and play. The children are required to wear socks in order to play. You may want to bring a spare pair of socks to keep in your child's cubby or book bag at the beginning of summer. Anyone who climbing over walls in jump and play houses will lose the next trip

All Other Trips

There are many other trips that we will go on with the Afterschool group. These trips all require the children to wear tennis shoes. Some of the trips will require the children to bring in bag lunches

X's and loss of field trips

Field trips are rewards for positive behavior. Children who receive an X will lose the next field trip. The children will receive a warning. After that they will receive an X and lose the next field trip. Some behaviors will result in an automatic X. The following are behavior that will result in an **automatic X**: (All children will be aware of what behaviors will result in automatic X)
